

**FRIDAY 24<sup>TH</sup> MARCH**

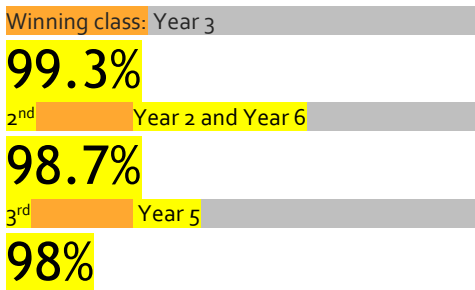


This year we are raising money for Red Nose Day by having a non-uniform day. We are asking children to donate £1 to dress up as their favourite red nose or to come head to toe in red.

- 4<sup>th</sup> – Sinai (25 points)

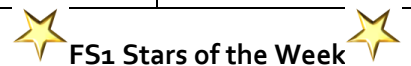
**Sporting Achievements**
