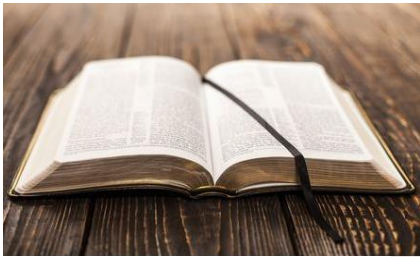


**THE ST ALBAN'S BIBLE**

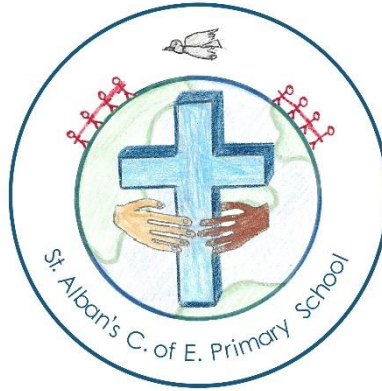
The names of the children who received the Lodge Bible are proudly displayed next to the school hall. Can you spot a member of our school staff who was awarded the Bible as a child?
