

PLATINUM AWARD

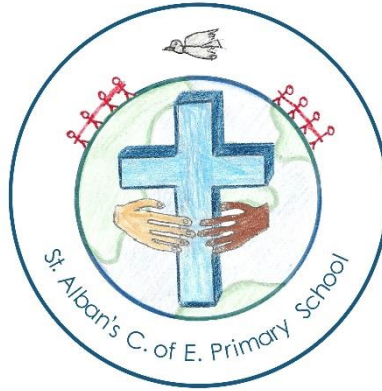
