Practical ways to support children reading at pink level



Look.

The dog is running.

- Scan the text and identify key words to support reading (dog, running). Use these words when discussing the pictures.
- What is the dog doing? Running.
- What does rrrrrrrunning begin with? Can you find that word on the page?
- Count the words on the page.
- Child points to the words while the adult reads. This helps develop the concept of a word.
- Search for a specific high frequency word in the text (**the**, is)
- Before reading play flashcard games.
