Due to our COVID Risk Assessment and to protect children, staff, visitors and parents we have to limit the number of parents visiting individual performances. We will provide you with 2 tickets per child for individual performances, in December (children under the age of 3 do not require a ticket). Unfortunately, we are unable to offer any additional tickets, if additional tickets are required can we please ask you to discuss this with other parents in your class to see if anyone has any free tickets they will not require.

In order to make the process run smoothly can we please ask:

- All adults must wear masks (unless medically exempt)
- Parents will enter and exit through the hall door from the playground. Doors will not open until 9.00 am for morning performances and 1.20 pm for afternoon performances.
- A barrier between parents and children will be in place - please do not step over the barrier.
- Please sign in and out on the sheet provided and sanitise your hands on entering/exiting the hall.

We really hope that parents will be able to join us and see your children perform. Due to unprecedented times, we will review our risk assessment closer to performance dates. If we feel it is unsafe to have parents in school then we may have to cancel the performance. Let's hope this doesn't happen!
