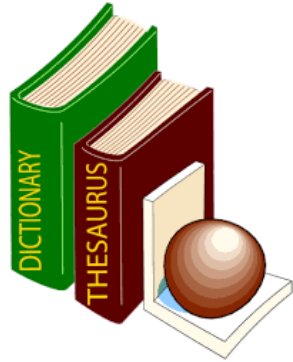
Reading Skills

Our reading skills are reading prompts based on the 2016 reading content domains found in the National Curriculum Test Framework documents.

Content domain reference	
2a	give / explain the meaning of words in context
2b	retrieve and record information / identify key details from fiction and non-fiction
2c	summarise main ideas from more than one paragraph
2d	make inferences from the text / explain and justify inferences with evidence from the text
2e	predict what might happen from details stated and implied
2f	identify / explain how information / narrative content is related and contributes to meaning as a whole
2g	identify / explain how meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases
2h	make comparisons within the text

They have been designed by the staff at St Albans to help embed the differing content domains within the short and long term memory of our children using pictures and words.

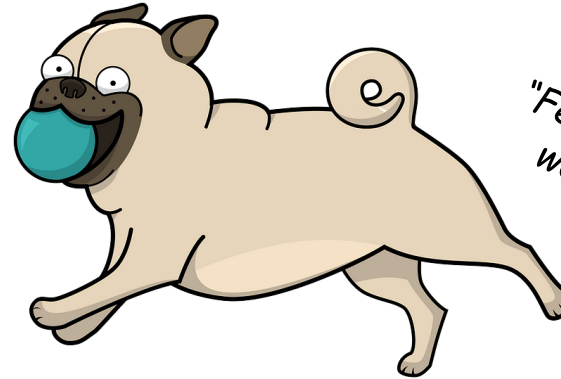

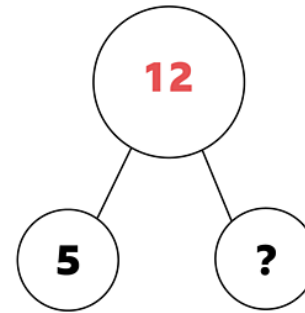
