Introduction

Strengths:

- Children love the sense of belonging to a house with their family and friends.
- Sports day had a true meaning with the colours children were in.
- Children led good assemblies- these are improving year on year.
- Children independently count the points and managed this with little support
- The use of gold badges for if houses win 3 consecutive times.
- Additional points for attendance.
- Carmel reading assemblies- promoting books
- Sinai class prayers worked well.
- Jericho - litter picking with Mr Hetherington.
- Child led assemblies on the school bullying policy and safeguarding policy- in reviews children could list what bullying was- stop (several times on purpose)

Ways forward:

- House teachers to lead their house without direction from the headteacher. Set assemblies, set activities, set times to meet.
- Change the meaning of house Jericho to Belonging. This follows our Equality training, where we questioned resilience and felt belonging fitted much better.
- Children to teach children playground games.
- Develop buddies. Every year 4 child has a buddy from year 6. Every year 5 child has a buddy from year 3. If they are worried or stuck what to do then they can go to their buddy.
- Carmel- reading assemblies
- Jericho- Green lunchbox competition
- Jordan - Set up the buddy system
- Sinai - Class prayers, Bible games to play in class.
