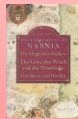

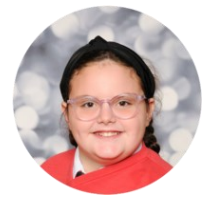

Author Profile: David Walliams Written by Thomas & Chanu

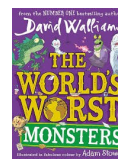

also include picture books illustrated by Tony Ross.

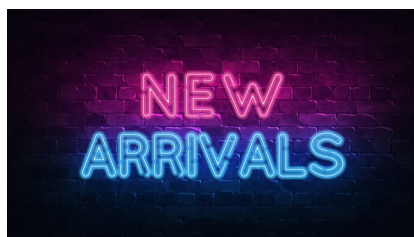
